Amber Bonine, Alexis Hoskinson, and Alek Royer were each awarded \$500 scholarships made possible by the generous contributions of HHSAA members. Thank you!!

Amber Bonine plans to attend Hutchinson Community College to study game design and animation. Amber's high school activities included student council; StuCo vice president; KAYS; H-Club; Art Club; tennis for four year and team captain; basketball manager for four years; softball; class officer; Scholars' Bowl; jazz band; Trash Cats; concert band; marching band; pep band steel drums; forensics; and Pratt Academic Olympics.
