



Warhawk Host Families: On May 28th, twenty plus players will arrive from various parts of the country to compete for the Haven Warhawks. These young men will need a place to stay for the duration of the season in the Haven/Colwich/Maize/Northwest Wichita area. Summer collegiate baseball leagues all over the country depend on generous host families to house players in order to operate, and we are no different. We hope that you will consider hosting a player. Many great and often lifelong relationships are forged between players and their host families. Host families will receive a free admission pass to home games to come watch and support their player if they choose.

The Role of a Host Family: The role of the host family is to provide housing and meals to the players. Housing requirements include a bed, a private room if at all possible, and access to a bathroom and kitchen. Players also need access to laundry services to wash uniforms and personal items. Host families are not asked to do the players' laundry. Hosts are asked to provide one-two meals a day. Players will arrive home late since games do not typically start on weeknights until 5-7pm. Meals will be provided by the team after games. Players are responsible for their own transportation, so a place to park will be needed. Other than room and board, host families are simply asked to monitor the player and help with anything they need. Most are new to the area so help finding their way around is appreciated.

Costs Involved: The largest cost during their stay is food. As a warning, these kids are growing athletes and can eat almost as much as you can feed them. We recommend that you simply make an extra helping or two of you normal meal and that is sufficient.

The Schedule: Players will report to the team Sunday, May 28th. The season will run May 31st-July 14th, followed by a regional tournament July 15th-18th. The NBC World Series follows if the team earns a berth, running July 22nd-August 6th. The team schedule can be viewed at havenwarhawks.com. Players report to practice in the early afternoon and then play games at night starting between 5-7pm. Players will play approximately six days a week.
